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Resolution 2798 (2025)

**Adopted by the Security Council at its 10031st meeting, on
31 October 2025**

The Security Council,

Reaffirming its commitment to supporting Colombia in establishing peace, justice and security,

Recognising the people of the Republic of Colombia's constitutional commitment to the peace process and *recalling* its relevant resolutions,

Welcoming progress made towards peace in Colombia, *recognising* the ongoing challenges in Colombia in this regard, *recalling* the efforts since the adoption of the 2016 Final Peace Agreement for Ending the Conflict and Building a Stable and Lasting Peace (the Final Agreement), *recalling* also the efforts in tackling structural factors underlying the conflict, *commending* notable efforts to date in this respect by the security forces and civil society including women and youth, *urging* greater efforts from relevant state institutions, and *encouraging* all stakeholders to work together to build on efforts to date and address ongoing challenges,

Noting in particular the continued violence in conflict-affected areas which affects all communities, including sexual violence and gender-based violence targeting women and girls, and *recalling* the disproportionate impact of the conflict on all vulnerable communities including women, children and persons belonging to marginalised communities,

Recognising the changing conflict dynamics in Colombia and *stressing* the importance of rural security and of strengthening the State's presence across conflict-affected regions, including through full implementation of the Final Agreement and complementary security policies,

Reaffirming Colombia's sovereign ownership of the implementation of the Final Agreement,

1. *Decides* to extend the mandate of the Verification Mission in Colombia until 31 October 2026, focusing on its primary function to support verification and monitoring of implementation of the Final Agreement pertaining to resolutions 2366 (2017) and section 1 of the Agreement as set out in 2673 (2023),

2. *Further decides* to discontinue the expansion of the mandate of the Verification Mission in Colombia to monitor ceasefires as set out in resolution 2694 (2023) and its associated resources,

3. *Requests* the Secretary-General to ensure coordination and efficiencies, including by ensuring that other activities in country are carried out by the most appropriate UN system entity,

4. *Expresses* its willingness to continue working with Colombia.
