DESCRIPTION OF REQUIREMENTS

- 1.0 The United Nations Verification Mission in Colombia (UNVMC) intends to solicit bids for the Rental of 99 Vehicles (4x4 Armoured & Conventional) including Repairs and Maintenance, Auto Body Repairs Services and Replacement of Tyres in accordance with the scope of work, general conditions and other related documents. The vehicles will be deployed throughout the Colombian territory in support of UNVMC which includes 11 regions and others .
- 1.1 The contract will be awarded to the proposer that clearly demonstrates through a written proposal and references a high degree of experience, ability, competency and best-practice in this services.
- 1.2 The awarded Contractor shall provide material, labour, tools, spare parts and equipment necessary for the repairs and maintenance services for the 99 rented vehicles as outlined in the Scope of Work (SOW).
- 2.0 The solicitation will be based on detailed Scope of Work (SOW), Technical Evaluation Criteria (Mandatory and Rated), Price Schedule, UN General Conditions of Contracts and other related documents which will be provided by UNVMC to all companies who respond to this EOI and qualify for the tender.
- 3.0 The requirements will include, but not limited to the following:
- a) Rental of 99 vehicles not older than 2015 make with maximum mileage between 60,000 70,000 kms per vehicle consisting of 4x4 WD armoured (Level III), 4x4 WD off road, SUV and Sedan (medium size).
- b) Provison of vehicle repairs and maintenance, auto body repairs services and replacement of tyres

including 24/7 road side vehicle technical assistance and recovery services in each region and remote locations where UNVMC has presence.

- 4.0 For this purpose, UNVMC will undertake a competitive bidding exercise shortly, accordingly would issue a Request for Proposal (RFP) to those companies who would express their interest and provide initial relevant information as to their ability to fulfill UNVMC's requirement.
- 5.0 In addition, the interested companies are requested to complete their registration at Level 2 on the United Nations Global Marketplace (www.ungm.org).
- 6.0 Please note on the following:
 - a) This EOI is not an invitation for submission of a bid/proposal.
- b) UNVMC reserves the right in selecting the invitees for the competitive bidding based on substantial and proven records of performance in the subject field of activities and mere expressing an interest would not automatically warrant for tender document.
 - c) UNVMC reserves the right to reject EOIs received after the above deadline.

SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS / INFORMATION (IF ANY)

- 7.0 MANDOTARY PRE-QUALIFICATION CRITERIA: The interested companies should meet the below Mandatory requirements (7.1 7.6), companies who fail to confirm compliance with the Mandatory requirements may not be considered for the upcoming tender.
- 7.1 Capability to provide repairs and maintenance services at UNVMC regional offices and local sites using fully equipped workshop vehicle (Mobile Workshop) to undertake the work.
- 7.2 Minimum six (6) months warranty covering both the workmanship and materials.
- 7.3 At least five (5) years experience in providing similar turnkey surface transport solutions.
- 7.4 Duly completed United Nations Global Marketplace (UNGM) vendor registration formalities at Level 2.
- 7.5 All vehicle must have SOAT and FULL CASCO insurance or equivalent covering all risks.
- 7.6 Duly completed and signed EOI Pre-Qualification Questionnaire and signed Vendor Response Form (attached).
